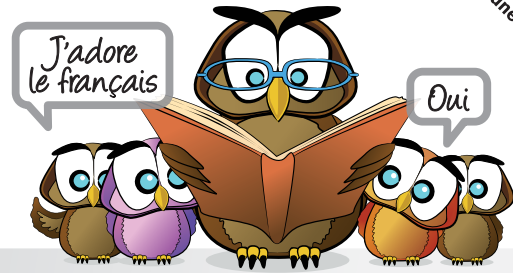


# Modern Languages Primary Conference – get ready for compulsory primary languages 2014!

Following the government's announcement that the teaching of a foreign language is to be compulsory at KS2 from September 2014, teachers need to prepare and plan for the new curriculum. This keynote will provide an overview of how primary modern languages should be delivered and the main changes since the last primary initiative.

**10.30** Workshop 1 Phonics in Modern Languages

Speaking a foreign language is the skill that children and adults often report finding the hardest to master. Using the synthetic phonics approach, children can quickly learn how to pronounce a foreign language accurately. This workshop will help teachers who lack confidence to pronounce French and Spanish correctly as well as proven techniques to use in the classroom when teaching children how to speak in the language.
